God's Omer Satisfies

Exodus 16:18 KJV

And when they did mete it with an omer, he that gathered much had nothing over, and he that gathered little had no lack; they gathered every man according to his eating.

God commanded all men to gather one omer per person in the household, not more, not less. When every man obeyed the command of God he was not left extra nor was he left wanting. The manna supplied their need. The miracle of this is that one measure satisfied a diverse multitude. Under normal circumstances, individuals according to their physical constitution would need varying amounts of food to be satisfied.

There were people in the congregation to whom an omer would be too much food; they were light eaters. There were others, with healthier appetites, that an omer would not be nearly enough to satiate their hunger. Yet, when the Israelites gathered according to God's command, the voracious eaters were not looking for more to eat and the less peckish were not forcing down extra. God's omer satisfied them all.

The Word of God is sufficient to satisfy all men. In our churches come great needs and small. The Word will feed them all. You will not leave hungry when God feeds with His heavenly manna.

The Spirit of God works in much the same manner. It matters not what people's needs are, He is sufficient to supply all those needs. There really is no telling how many needs are met in one church service through a move of the Spirit and the preaching of God's Word. God's measure that day will suffice!
