All Scripture Is Profitable

Some theologians teach that only the letter to the Laodiceans holds a message for us today. The apostle Paul taught, **All Scripture is given by inspiration of God (Every Scripture is Godbreathed** AMP), and is profitable... (2 Tim. 3:16). Every Scripture from Genesis 1:1 to Revelation 22:21 is profitable.

Paul lists the areas in which all Scripture is profitable: ...for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness (v. 16). We all especially need instruction in righteousness, which is right standing with God. We need to study more than our favorite passages—we need the *entire* Word.

Some theologians and ministers explain away the Word of God. They declare that certain things are not for today, having ceased at the end of a certain period or when a certain man died. Translations produced by modern theologians reduce God's Word to being just another book with no chance of changing a person's life. For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ, for it is the power of God to salvation (Rom. 1:16).

All seven letters to the churches are vitally important to us, because they are the inspired Word of God. Each contains a message for us—either instruction or warnings for us to heed, lest we fall into the same snares as six of the churches.
