Jeremiah 26:2 Thus saith the Lord; Stand in the court of the Lord's house, and speak unto all the cities of Judah, which come to worship in the Lord's house, all the words that I command thee to speak unto them; diminish not a word:

The divine command given to the prophet Jeremiah stands as an ordinance to all Preachers. *Diminish not a Word!* The Lord warned him. How many churches that are slight in power should be in might this hour? But they languish in defeat and are servants to this world, the flesh, and Satan, all because a preacher diminished the word. Jeremiah preached to his own, a people he loved and cherished. After pronouncing curse and warning, he may have been tempted to take a lighter stance or soften the mighty and inconvenient counsel of Jehovah.

But the Lord said, *Diminish not a Word*! Do not soften it, do not water it down, speak what I command you.

The people may stare you down, they may be offended by the frankness of God's precepts so freely spoken in public, they may walk out, they may threaten, but you Man of God, Diminish not a Word! Speak and preach with longsuffering and love the whole counsel of the Lord. For by this word, they shall be saved.

Will we please men, or will we please God? You may feel the pressure to answer to men on this earth, but you will ultimately answer to God in heaven. May you be able to say I diminished not a word! Are there Trinitarians in your midst? Preach the Revelation of God in Christ! Are there denominal visitors on your pews? Preach that ye must be born again of the Water and of the Spirit. Are there lukewarm saints? Preach prayer and consecration! Fear only God, dear minister, and diminish not a word!!
