Keys To Understanding:
The Oneness of God

THE ONENESS OF GOD

The Bible has all the answers that we need to know to understand the nature of God. Relying on man-made traditions and ancient creeds to comprehend God only confuses matters. The Scriptures alone give us a clear picture of Jesus Christ.

SECTION # 1 – GOD IS ONE (NUMERICALLY)

Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God is one LORD. (Deuteronomy 6:4)

For though there be that are called gods, whether in heaven or in earth, (as there be gods many, and lords many,) but to us *there is but one* God, the Father, of whom are all things, and we in him; and one Lord Jesus Christ, by whom are all things, and we by him. (1 Corinthians 8:5-6)

Thus saith the LORD, thy redeemer, and he that formed thee from the womb, I am the LORD that maketh all things; that stretcheth forth the heavens alone; that spreadeth abroad the earth by myself. (Isaiah 44:24)

Fear ye not, neither be afraid: have not I told thee from that time, and have declared it? ye are even my witnesses. Is there a God beside me? yea, there is no God; I know not any. (Isaiah 44:8)

Ye are my witnesses, saith the LORD, and my servant whom I have chosen: that ye may know and believe me, and understand that I am he: before me there was no God formed, neither shall there be after me. (Isaiah 43:10)

SECTION #2 – NAMES, TITLES, AND ATTRIBUTES OF GOD

I am the LORD, your Holy One, the creator of Israel, your King. (Isaiah 43:15)

Thus saith the LORD the King of Israel, and his redeemer the LORD of hosts; I *am* the first, and I *am* the last; and beside me there is no God. (Isaiah 44:6)

I, even I, am the LORD; and beside me there is no saviour. (Isaiah 43:11)

Bless the LORD, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits: Who forgiveth all thine iniquities; who healeth all thy diseases. (Psalms 103:2-3)

For thou, Lord, art good, and ready to forgive; and plenteous in mercy unto all them that call upon thee. (Psalms 86:5)

SECTION #3 – NAMES, TITLES, AND ATTRIBUTES OF JESUS CHRIST

These shall make war with the Lamb, and the Lamb shall overcome them: for he is Lord of lords, and King of kings: and they that are with him are called, and chosen, and faithful. (Revelation 17:14)

And when I saw him, I fell at his feet as dead. And he laid his right hand upon me, saying unto me, Fear not; I am the first and the last. (Revelation 1:17)

For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Saviour, which is Christ the Lord. (Luke 2:11)

But when Jesus knew it, he withdrew himself from thence: and great multitudes followed him, and he healed them all. (Matthew 12:15)

When Jesus saw their faith, he said unto the sick of the palsy, Son, thy sins be forgiven thee. (Mark 2:5)

Why doth this man thus speak blasphemies? who can forgive sins but God only? (Mark 2:7)

SECTION #4 – WHAT THE BIBLE SAYS ABOUT JESUS CHRIST

To wit, that God was in Christ, reconciling the world unto himself, not imputing their trespasses unto them; and hath committed unto us the word of reconciliation. (2 Corinthians 5:19)

And without controversy great is the mystery of godliness: God was manifest in the flesh, justified in the Spirit, seen of angels, preached unto the Gentiles, believed on in the world, received up into glory. (1 Timothy 3:16)

And we know that the Son of God is come, and hath given us an understanding, that we may know him that is true, and we are in him that is true, even in his Son Jesus Christ. This is the true God, and eternal life. (1 John 5:20)

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. (John 1:1)

SECTION # 5—THERE IS ONLY ONE GOD

I and my Father are one. (John 10:30)

Jesus saith unto him, Have I been so long time with you, and yet hast thou not known me, Philip? he that hath seen me hath seen the Father; and how sayest thou then, Show us the Father? (John 14:9)

I said therefore unto you, that ye shall die in your sins: for if ye believe not that I am *he*, ye shall die in your sins. (John 8:24)

To the only wise God our Savior, be glory and majesty, dominion and power, both now and ever. Amen. (Jude 1:25)
