Psalm 78:39

39 For he remembered that they were but flesh; a wind that passeth away, and cometh not again.

We all have people in our churches who have or are currently undergoing some kind of crisis. I believe that the closer we get to the coming of the Lord, that Satan is pulling out all of the stops to get not only the saints of God, but the ministry distracted.

We believe in God, we trust God, we love God, irregardless of whatever we are going through.

It may very well be the scripture saints in the church use with the besetting sin that has got them trapped. Jesus, I'm sorry, remember I'm flesh.

The other day I was in prayer and I asked the Lord to please forgive me and have patience with me as I battle through this powerful emotion called fear. I reminded Him again to remember that I am but flesh.

That is when He reminded me, that yes, I may be but flesh, but I am filled with the Holy Ghost. Greater is He that is in me, than he that is in the world. He reminded me that I am supposed to be able to do all things through Him, which strengthens me...

There is one thing to know the scriptures, but knowledge isn't enough, we have to apply that truth to our lives irregardless of what is going on in our lives.

He has not given us the spirit of fear, the Spirit that we have is of power, love, and a SOUND mind. Fear has torment...

1 Kings 19:13

And it was [so], when Elijah heard [it], that he wrapped his face in his mantle, and went out, and stood in the entering in of the cave. And, behold, [there came] a voice unto him, and said, What doest thou here, Elijah?

There are times we just need to wrap our face in our mantle and keep walking where the Lord is taking us. Since when can the clay talk back to the potter and ask, what are you doing? I don't like this. Sometimes we can get a little misguided and think that our feelings are going to make God change His mind. He reminded me, that His grace was sufficient for me; when He reminded me of that, I immediately got off the woe is me couch and got glad.

2 Corinthians 12:9

And he said unto me, My grace is sufficient for thee: for my strength is made perfect in weakness. Most gladly therefore will I rather glory in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me.

We need His power to rest upon us through whatever situation we find ourselves in.

Philippians 4:19

But my God shall supply all your need according to his riches in glory by Christ Jesus.

When my heart is overwhelmed, lead me to the rock that is higher than I. Instead of reminding God of our weaknesses, We need to start reminding our flesh of HIS strengths.

That's when God wants to hear you sing
