Millions of nonCatholics, many qualified theologians, Bible scholars, etc., believe that the above Scriptures in the Book of Revelation refer to the Catholic Church of Rome.

It was and is primarily and self-proclaimedly a Reliquary full of ancient Greek and Roman religious beliefs and practices.
