Romans 8:28 "And we know that all things work together (sunergeo) for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to *his* purpose."

From G4904; to be a fellow worker, that is, co-operate: - help (work) with, work (-er) together.

Sunergeo is the foundation of our word "synergism." Synergism describes the interaction of various agents or conditions in such a way that the total effect is greater than the sum of the individual effects.

This is the word that God uses to describe what is promised here. Something is happening here that takes us (them that love God, to them who are the called according to [His] purpose) beyond our individual limitations and creates something new, dynamic, and beautiful.

Not only is God the potter that fashions the clay into a vessel of His design, but He is also the weaver that creates the tapestry from the multi-colored threads of time and circumstance.
